Dear Governor Bob Taft,

On behalf of the Department of Development's Ohio Investment in Training Program (OITP), I am pleased to present the OITP Annual Report for Fiscal Year 2003. This report contains the following: (1) various analyses of programmatic activity since 1995; (2) a listing and description of all OITP grants entered into during fiscal year 2003, and (3) a report detailing the percent of OITP grants used for all projects closed during the calendar years 1999 through 2003.

The OITP supports companies that are making investments in facilities, equipment and training that result in the retention or creation of jobs for Ohioans. This program is one of the few programs in Ohio that provides direct financial support to employers for training. The flexibility of the OITP allows employers the ability to choose the training provider, whether it is a company employee, an Ohio educational facility, or a training vendor. The program defrays eligible training expenses of up to fifty percent of the costs for instructor salaries and materials and travel expenses. Funds are distributed to companies on a reimbursement basis.

As evidenced by this report, the OITP has significant impact over the years on the Ohio's workforce. Since July 1, 1998, 1,194 economic development projects have benefited from nearly \$224.6 million in training commitments. Of the 1,194 projects, 646 have been completed and closed and the other 548 remain active. OITP's assistance helped defray the training costs of over 55,000 new employees and more than 142,000 existing workers.

Training and education of the state's workforce is absolutely essential if Ohio's businesses are to remain competitive and the state's economy is to thrive. I believe the OITP has contributed to improving the skills of Ohio's workers and strengthening the competitiveness of its businesses. As you review the details of this report I believe the true economic impact of the program will become evident.

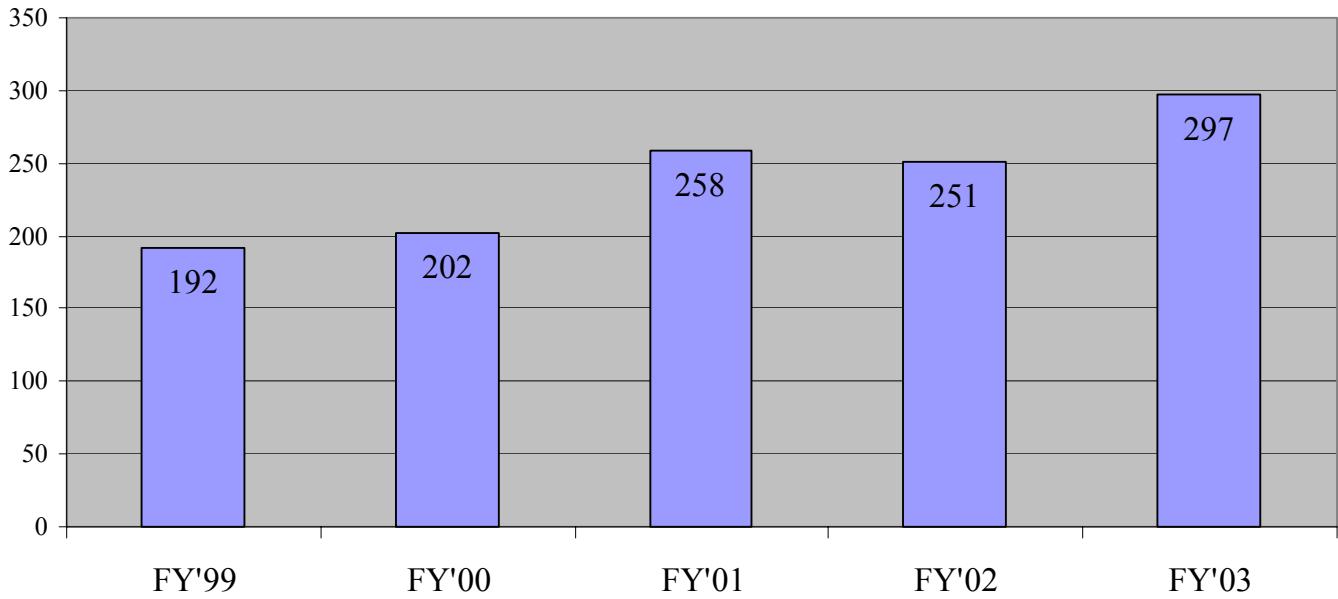


Figure 2: Comparison of Total New Jobs Committed

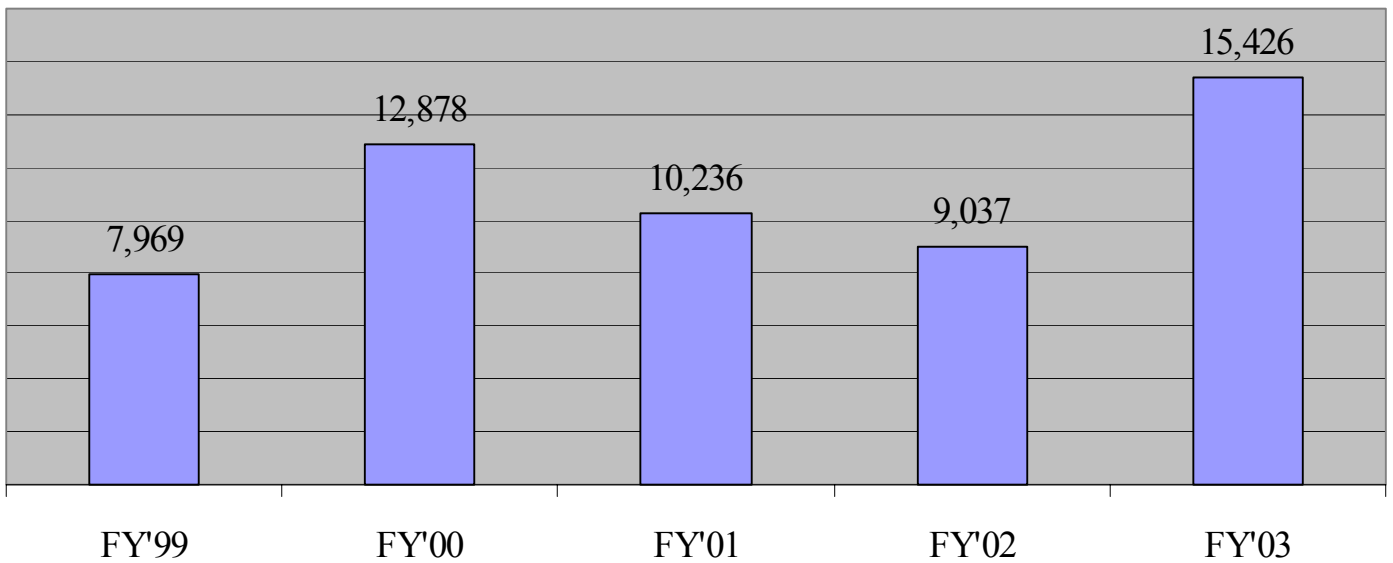


Figure 3: Comparison of Total Jobs Retained

Table 1 offers an annual comparison of projects approved by OITP since 1999. Table 1 shows the steady increase in the number of projects funded and the continuing decrease in program funds over the past three years. Both new job commitments (see Figure 2) and total job retention commitments (see Figure 3) experienced increases over the past five years.

Fiscal Years 1999-2003

Fiscal Years 1999-2003

Fiscal Years 1999 - 2003

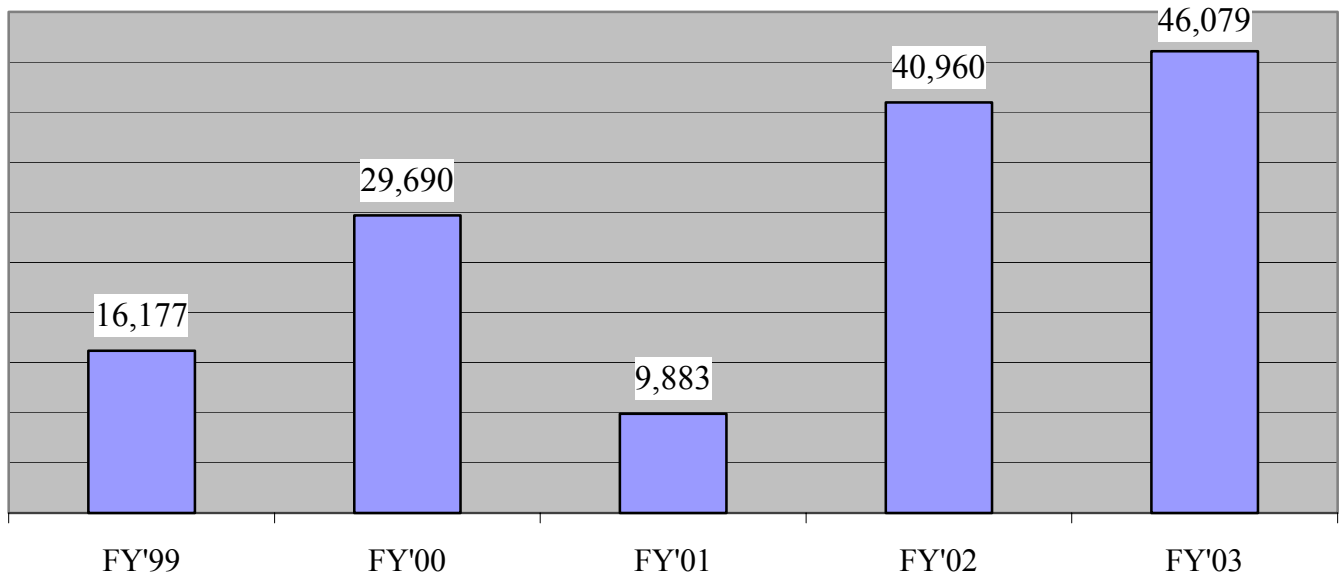
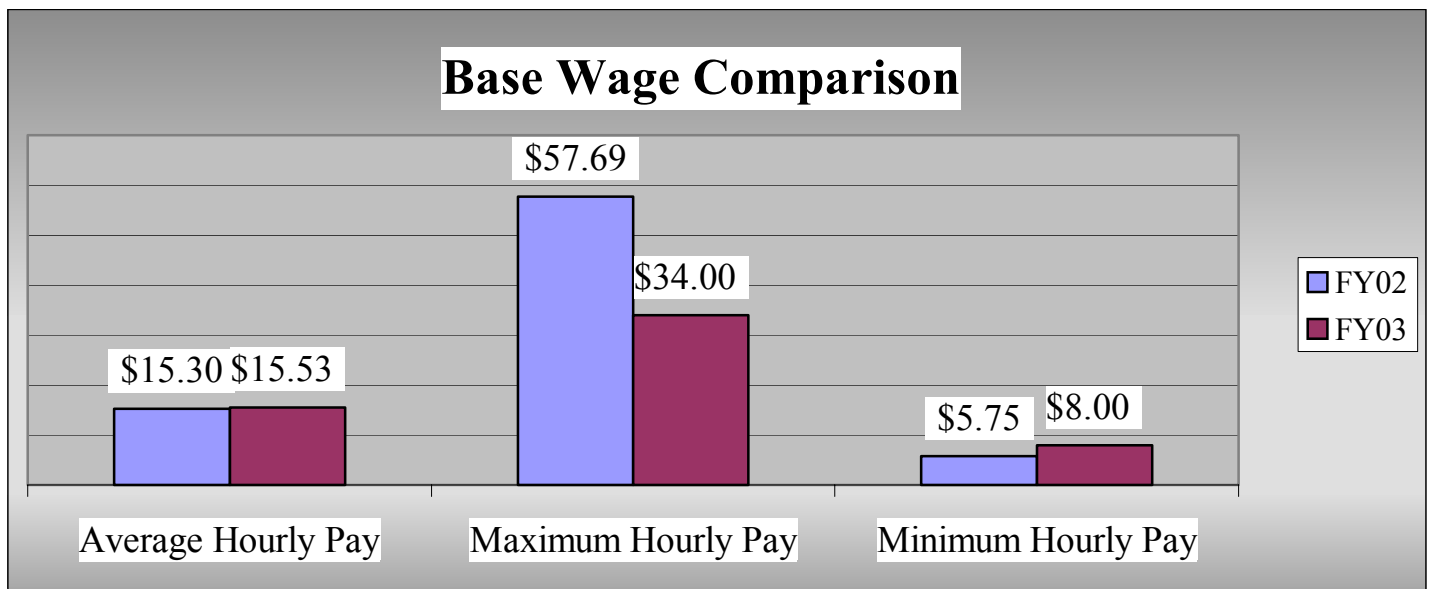
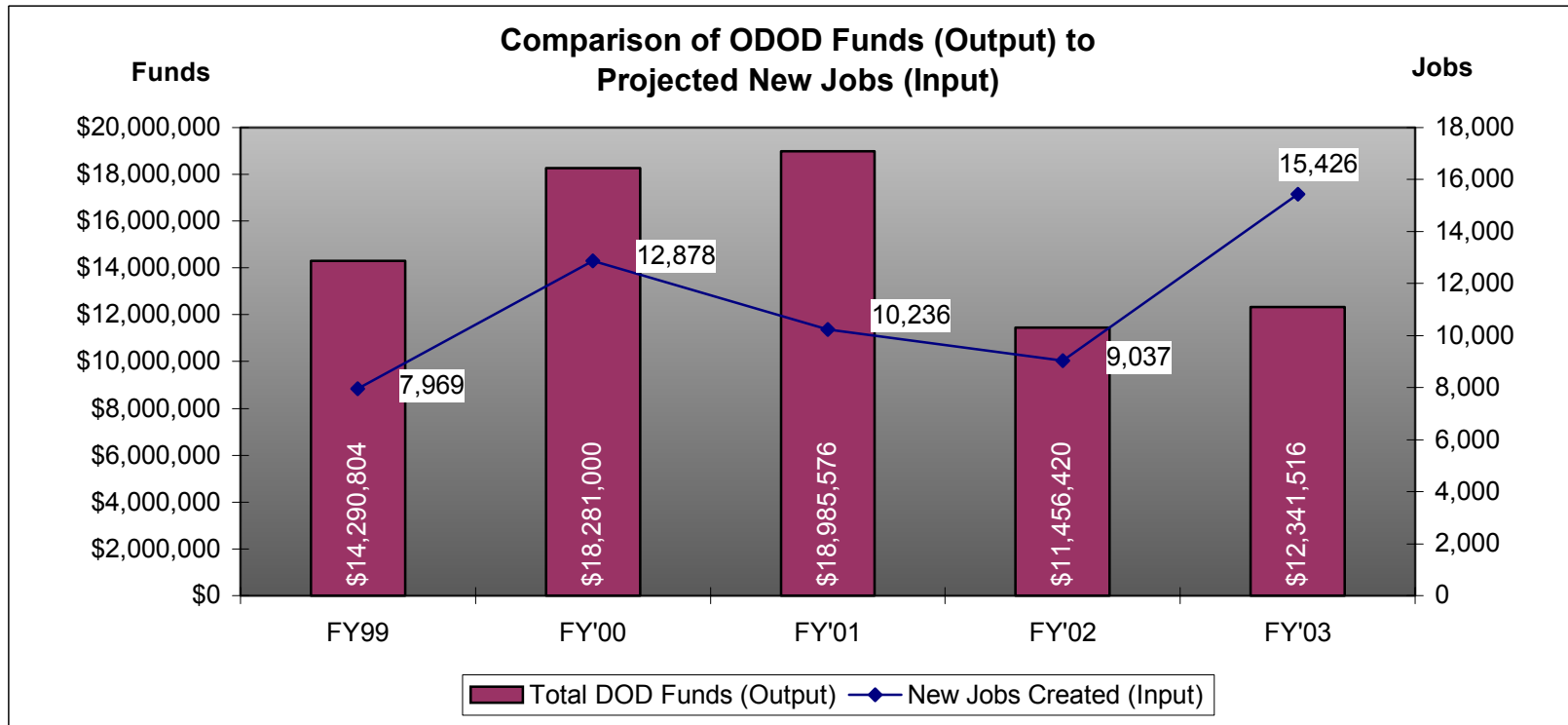


Figure 4: Comparison of Hourly Wage Rate Commitments

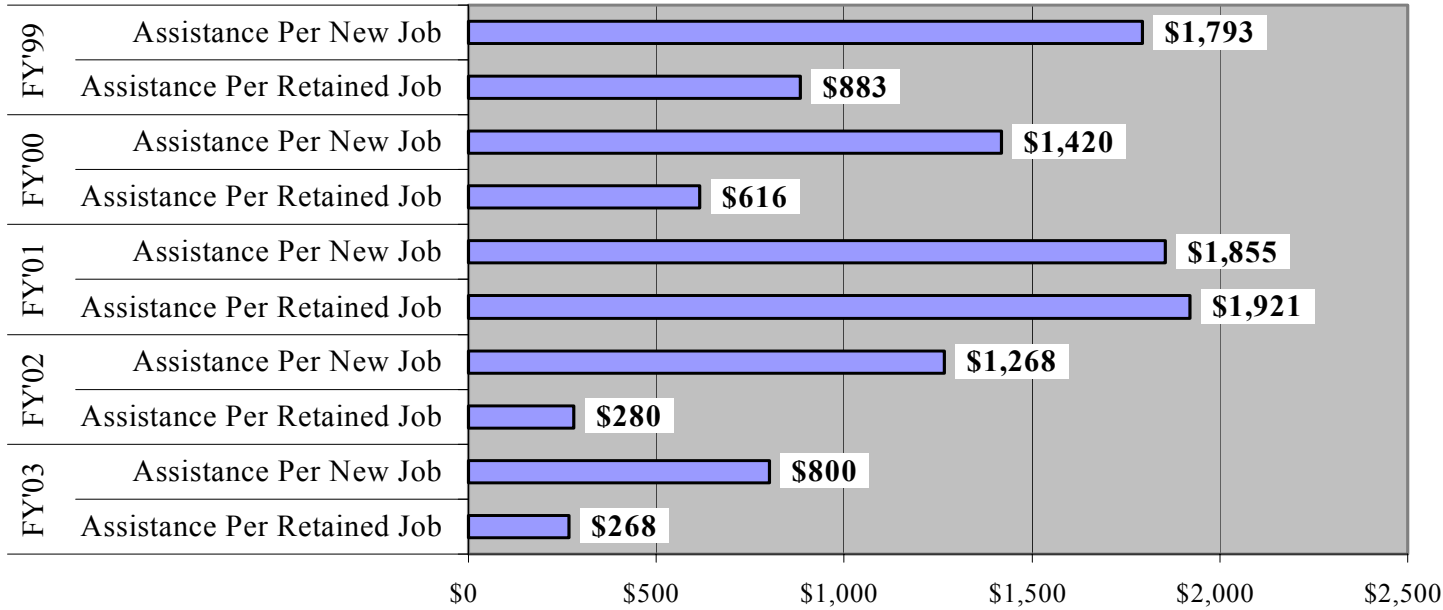
Figure 5: Return on Investment

In Figure 5 the Return on Investment (ROI) for the program is obvious when you look at the decrease in OITP's budget and the increase in commitments from the grantees. OITP has a 55 percent increase in projects and a 14 percent decrease in funds from FY99 to FY03. OITP has increased new job commitments by 94 percent and retained jobs are up 185 percent over the same period. OITP also shows a 102 percent increase in people trained and a 4,103 percent increase in capital investment.

Figure 5 compares the obligations made by the grantees for new jobs (Input) and the assistance they received from OITP (Output). As the chart shows, the number of new jobs has increased substantially and the amount of the annual budget has decreased, showing a greater return on the dollar.

In Figure 6, OITP assistance per new and retained jobs has been reduced by at least 50 percent since FY99. As the chart shows, assistance per new job is reduced from \$1,793 to \$800 and the retained job is reduced from \$883 to \$268.

Fiscal Years 1999 – 2003

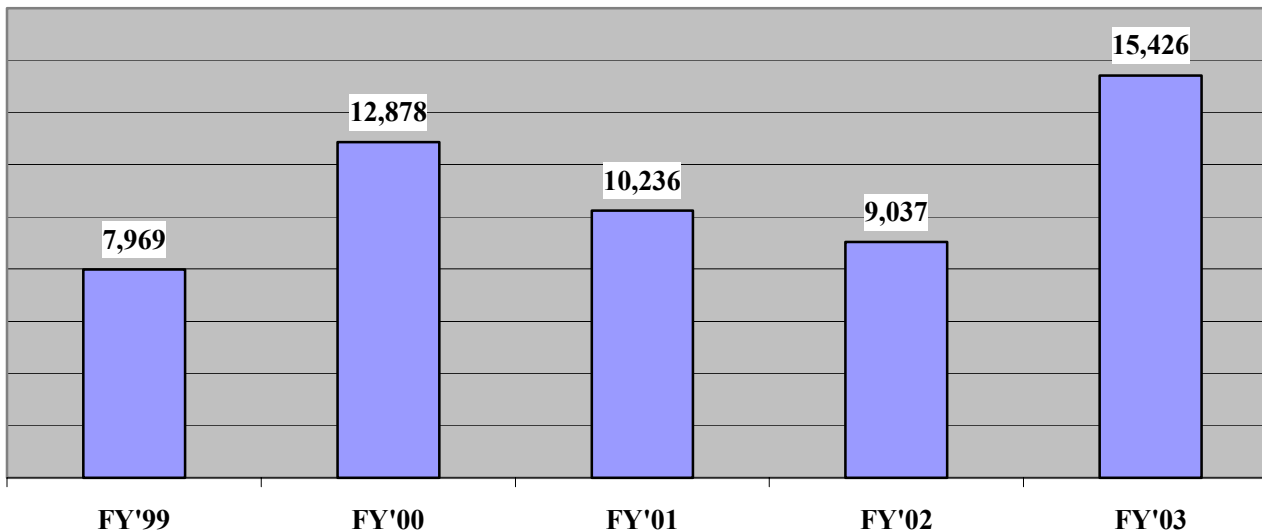


Figure 7 shows the impact of the recent economy on new job creation. OITP has recovered greatly since FY'01. The number of new jobs dropped over 38% from FY'00 to FY'01 with 10,236 new jobs compared to 12,878 new jobs in FY'00. In FY'03 that number increased 44% with 15,426 new jobs.

Fiscal Years 1999 – 2003

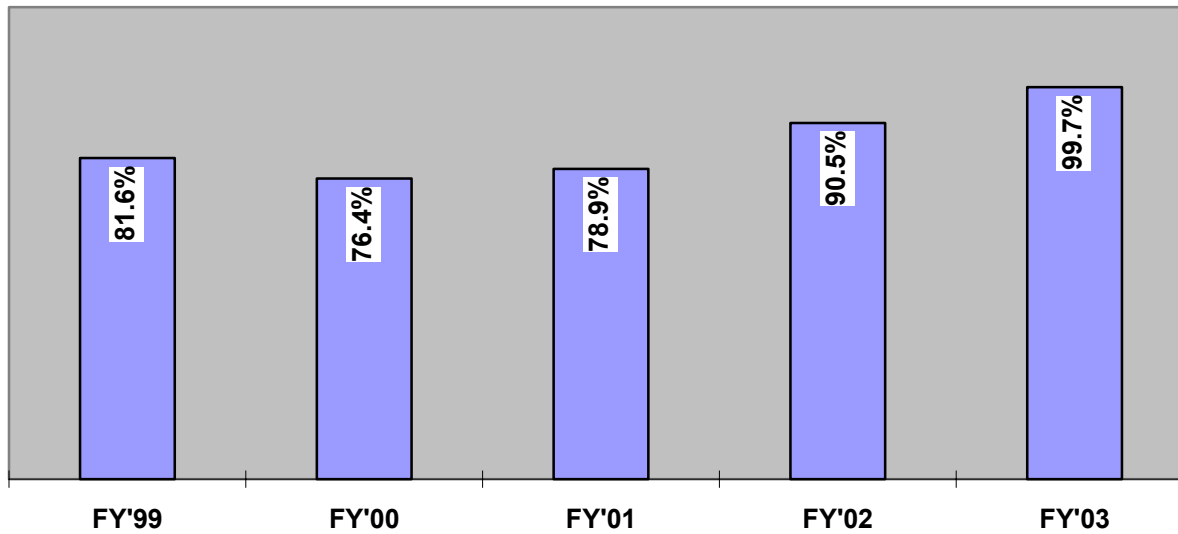


Figure 8 demonstrates that OITP is using its limited budget more effectively. Grant amounts have been reduced to more closely align with company needs.

Figure 8 shows that in FY'99 grants were being closed with only 81 percent of the grant funds being used. In FY'03 the grants are being closed using nearly 100 percent of the grant funds.

Fiscal Years 1999 – 2003

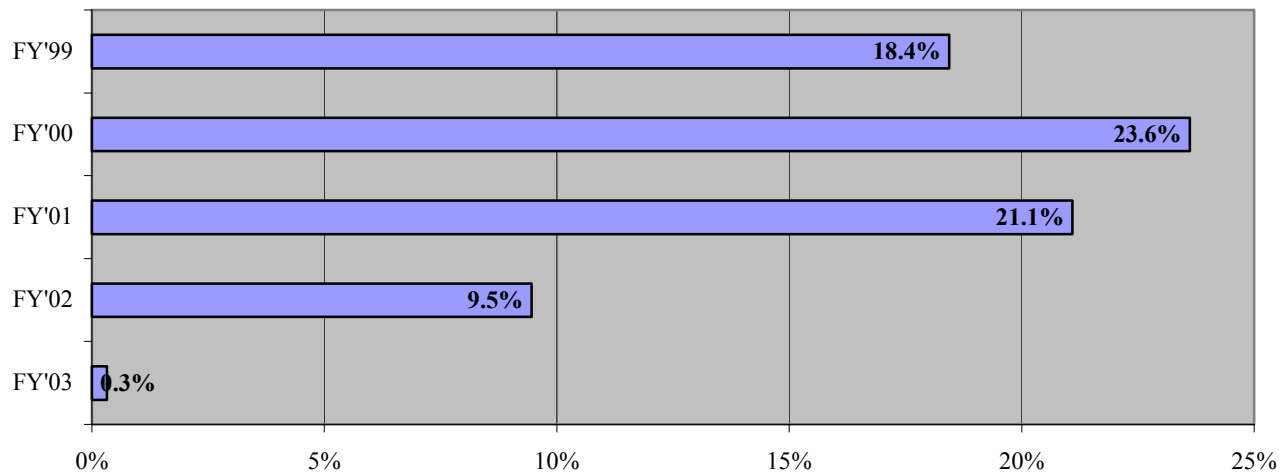


Figure 9 demonstrates that the amount of money the companies left unspent when they closed their grants has decreased over 98 percent from FY'99 to FY'03

Fiscal Years 2002 – 2003

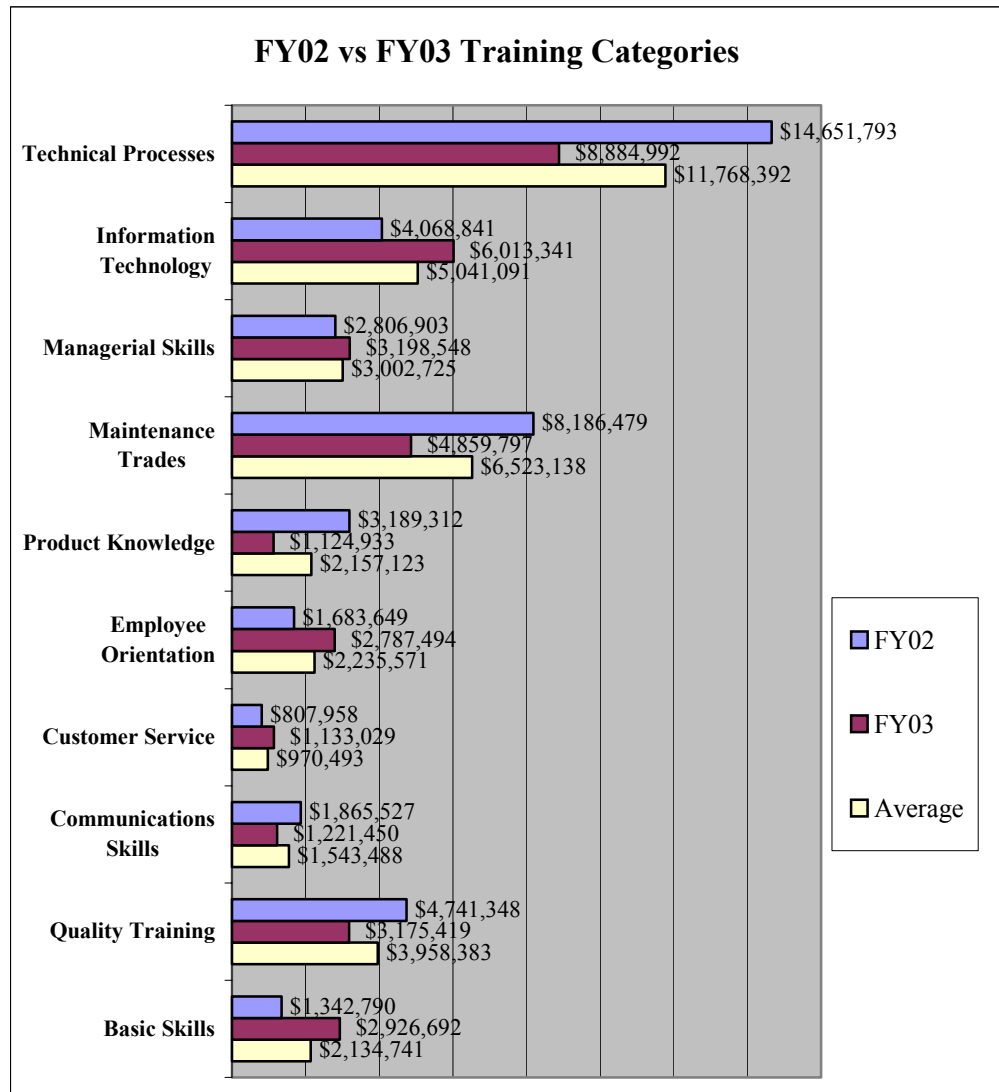

Fiscal Years 2002-2003

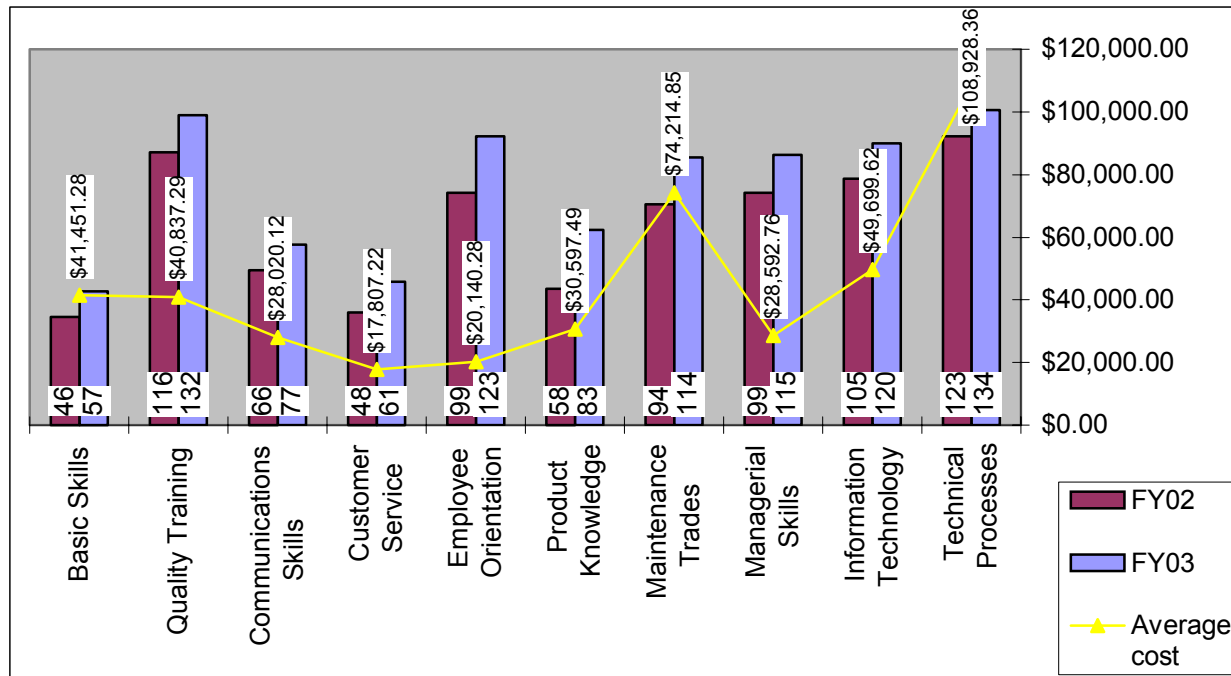

Fiscal Years 2002 – 2003

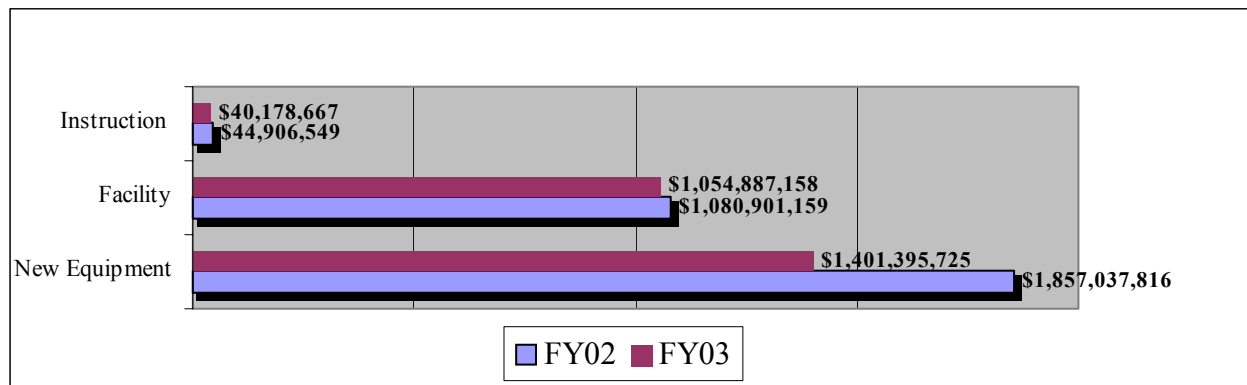


Figure 12 shows the amount of project funds devoted to training versus invested in facility and equipment.
