From retail and manufacturing to healthcare and financial services, Ohio is home to an array of market-leading employers. *Ohio's Major Employers* is an informative, must-read report that provides an in-depth review of the leading employers that drive Ohio's economy. I am pleased to present these twelve tables of data in three sections for your review.

With more than 150 stores and four distribution centers, Wal-Mart Stores has been identified as the private sector employer with the largest total employee headcount in Ohio. Healthcare facilities such as The Cleveland Clinic and retail giants like Kroger make up the remaining top ten. The list identifies 91 firms and institutions that have 3,000 or more employees.

Section two highlights lists of Ohio companies published in national magazines. Cardinal Health of Dublin is identified as having the largest annual revenues of any public corporation in Ohio. *Fortune Magazine* identifies 60 public corporations with headquarters in Ohio in its Top 1000 Corporations list published in April of each year. Ohio is fifth in the nation for the number of headquarters in the State. Lists from *Forbes*, *Standard & Poors*, and *Inc Magazine* are also highlighted in this section.
