

### FY 2013 Homeless Crisis Response Program Emergency Shelter Historical Funding Levels

All projects submitted for Emergency Shelter funds will compete through a competitive review process. The FY 2013 Ohio Consolidated Plan states that currently funded projects will have access to a 70 percent renewal allocation with any amounts more than that possible through a competitive evaluation. The Office of Community Development reserves the right to fund projects at less than the amount requested. Based on the total funds available, it is likely that certain projects may receive a one-year allocation.
