- 2006-2010 American Community Survey (ACS) Low/Moderate Income Summary Data (LMISD) data was released June 10, 2014
- Data will be used to qualify projects under the area benefit national objective for PY 2014 open cycle programs (Residential Public Infrastructure, Discretionary-Targets of Opportunity, and Appalachian Regional Commission-HUD Basic Agency) and new activity amendments for PY 2014 Community Development Program
- Data will be used to qualify projects for the PY 2015 Community Development Program


2006-2010 ACS LMISD replaces 2000 Census (2007 update)

American Community Survey

Qualifying Area Benefit Projects:

Determine the service area

Determine whether the service area matches a jurisdiction for which ACS data exists (Place or Census Tract/Block Group)

Determine whether area is LMI by ACS or whether survey is needed to qualify the project

American Community Survey

If service area does not match ACS jurisdiction:

Income survey service area

Combine ACS jurisdiction data with income survey

Use a Net Effect Certification for service areas that are less than 75 percent of an ACS jurisdiction and homogeneous to that ACS jurisdiction

American Community Survey

OCD will develop a policy notice on qualifying projects under the area benefit national objective

Policy notice will include an updated income survey policy:

- Income surveys conducted after December 31, 2010 will be accepted
- Surveys valid for 5 years (unless conducted prior to December 31, 2010)
- Surveys use randomization of households, comply with minimum sample size requirements, and are certified by community CEO

American Community Survey

HUD expects to receive ACS LMISD every 5 years (July 2019, July 2024, July 2029)


OCD expects to use 2006-2010 ACS LMISD to qualify CDP area benefit projects for PY 2015-PY 2019

OCD expects to use 2011-2015 ACS LMISD to qualify CDP area benefit projects for PY 2020-PY 2024

Income Surveys

- Identify Service Area
- Determine the Number of Households in the Area
- Compile a List of Household Addresses
- Randomize the Addresses on the List
- Determine Minimum Sample Size
- Survey Households
- Compile Results
